

MUSIC ON HOLD MUSIC LICENSE AGREEMENT

1. This Music License Agreement is for use only in conjunction with Licensee's paid invoice/receipt which contains Licensee's business name and address where the Music On Hold has been licensed for use*.
2. Mark of the Clark, Inc. (Licensor) grants a single non-exclusive license for use of the Music On Hold Package ("the music") to the business (Licensee) as indicated on Licensee's paid invoice/receipt. Licensor warrants it has full power and authority to grant this license and permission to use.
3. It is specifically understood and agreed that Licensee does not acquire any ownership rights or any underlying copyrights, as these rights remain the property of the original copyright holder, including any modifications made to the music.
4. This license grants Licensee the non-exclusive right to play the music **solely for use as Music On Hold at Licensee's business location**. Any other use of the music is not permitted.
5. Licensee shall have the non-exclusive right, in perpetuity, for the life of the business, or 99 years, to use the music for the purposes of providing Music On Hold from Licensee's place of business using Licensee's telephone equipment and for no other use. Solely as it pertains to uses described in this paragraph, this license is a Direct License. Performing rights for the uses described in this paragraph have been paid directly to Licensor.
6. Unless otherwise specified in this Music License Agreement, this license is personal to Licensee and shall not be assigned by any act of Licensee or by operation of law unless in connection with a transfer of substantially all of the assets of Licensee or otherwise with the consent of Licensor.
7. Licensor shall have the right to immediately terminate this Music License Agreement by giving written notice to Licensee in the event Licensee breaches any of its terms and provision, including non-payment of license fee.
8. This Music License Agreement is governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Tennessee, County of Davidson, including the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee.
9. This Music License Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with regard to the subject hereof, and revokes and supersedes any and all prior agreements between the parties, including any option agreements, oral agreements, and written agreements, and is intended as a final expression of their agreement.
10. Use of the music by anyone providing a Music On Hold service to other 3rd parties is prohibited.

** The music may only be used at one location unless Licensee pays a License fee for multiple locations. One license fee is required per location. If licensing for multiple locations, add the number of Licenses during checkout.*
